

An Online Guest Lecture on **Ethics of Digital Presence** was organized by the Internal Complaints Committee of Sir Sayyid College of Arts, Commerce & Science, Aurangabad on 09 June 2021 at 12:00 p.m. via Zoom App. Prof. Aparna Saraf, Professor & Head, Department of Commerce & Mgt. Science, Maulana Azad College, Aurangabad was the speaker.

Mohammed Ahmeduddin, Asst. Prof. in English and member of I.C.C. explained the aims and objectives of the Internal Complaints Committee and the guest lecture. Dr. Nishat Parveen, Associate Prof. in Chemistry and the member of I.C.C. gave the introduction of the guest speaker. Prof. Aparna Saraf in her lecture talked about the Digital presence and the ethics that are associated with it. She told that we have become part and parcel of it and pandemic has intensified this to large extent and compelled many of us to become present on the digital platform. She emphasized on the urgent necessity to make ourselves digitally literate. Prof. Aparna Saraf said we should be aware of sharing our personal information, location, photos because access to data is there. She also talked about Big- data, Machine Learning, Artificial Intelligence.

The dark side of digital presence includes data leakage, hacking, cat phishing, cyber-crimes whereas personal bonding, connect with people across borders, community building, charity, crowd funding etc. are some aspects of the bright side of it. She said ethics is nothing but the rules and regulations that should be adopted and followed so that nobody else is hurt. There are some ethical challenges like oversharing, unauthentic content and insensitivity to others and these can be resolved by understanding the scenario, accepting and adapting.

As many as 44 participants attended the online guest lecture. Mohammed Ahmeduddin conducted the proceedings of the guest lecture while Dr. Sangeta Saraf, Professor in Botany and Incharge, I.C.C. proposed vote of thanks.

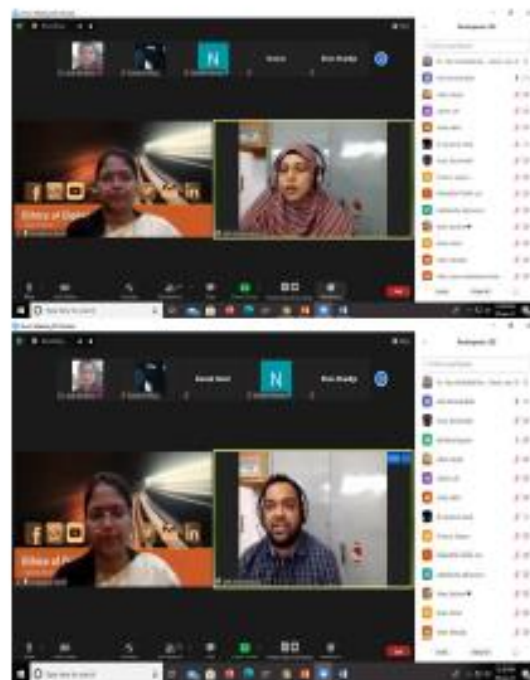

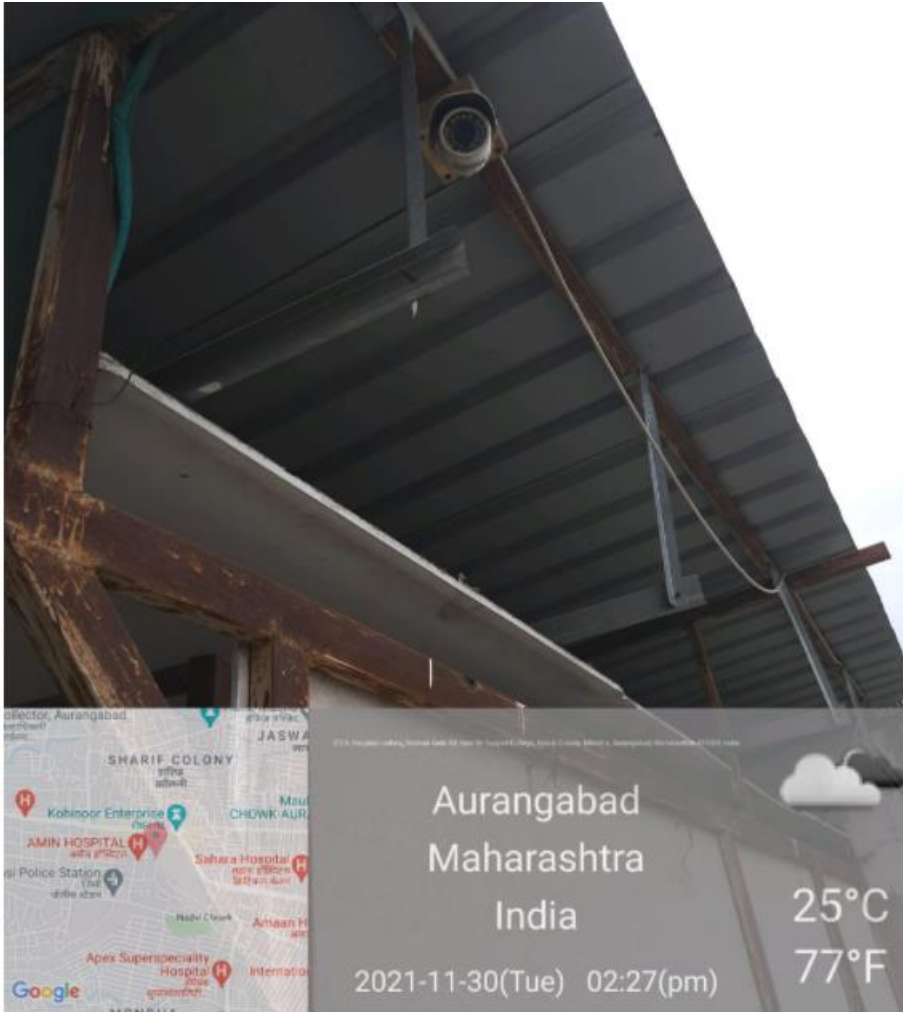


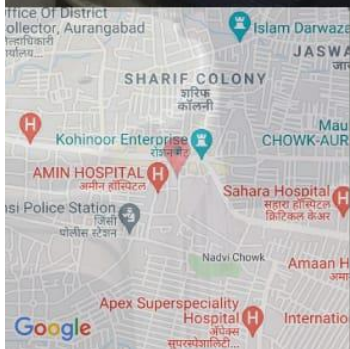
